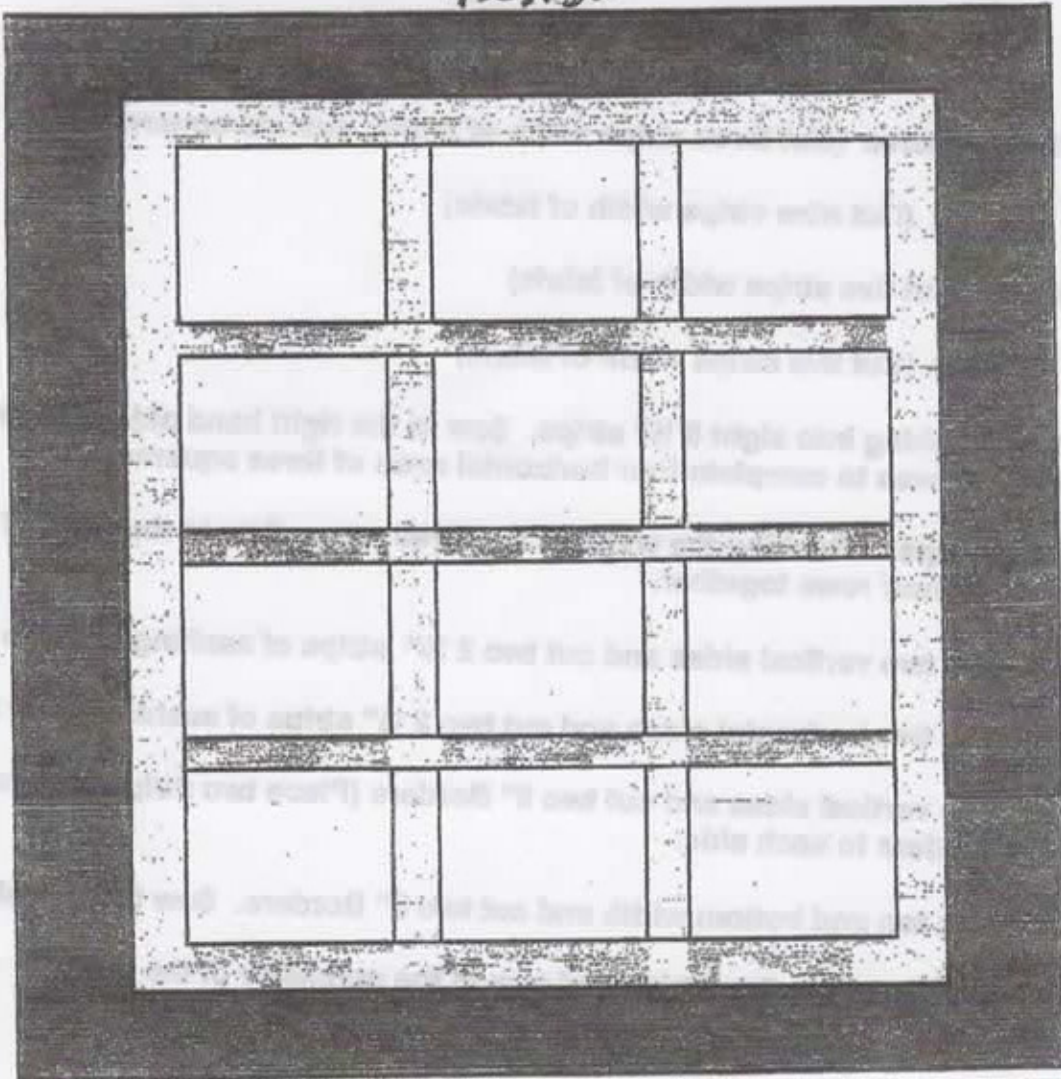

12 8 ½" Blocks - 3 strips width of fabric

2 ½" Sashing Strips - 9 strips width of fabric

5" Borders - 5 strips width of fabric

2 ½" Binding - 5 strips width of fabric

12 - 8 ½" squares (Cut three strips width of fabric; cut into squares)

2 ½" Sashing (Cut nine strips width of fabric)

5" Border (Cut five strips width of fabric)

2 ½" Binding (Cut five strips width of fabric)

Cut 2 ½" Sashing into eight 8 ½" strips. Sew to the right hand side of eight 8 ½" squares. Connect squares to complete four horizontal rows of three squares.

Cut three strips of Sashing the width of the three rows. Sew to the rows of squares and then sew all four rows together.

Measure the two vertical sides and cut two 2 ½" strips of sashing. Sew to each side.

Measure the two horizontal sides and cut two 2 ½" strips of sashing. Sew to each side.

Measure the vertical sides and cut two 5" Borders (Piece two strips together if necessary) Sew the borders to each side.

Measure the top and bottom width and cut two 5" Borders. Sew to each side.

Piece together the binding strips and sew to the perimeter of the quilt.
