Tease (T's)



Finished band is about 7" x 42"

Fabric

You will need 3 contrasting fabrics for the Tease band. Fabrics A and C are the T's and fabric B is the background (the gold fabric in the example). Cut all strips the width of the fabric (selvage to selvage).

- Fabric A (turquoise in example)
 - Cut (2) 1 ¼" strips
 - Cut (1) 1 ½" strip
- Fabric B (gold in example)
 - Cut (2) 1 ¼" strips
 - Cut (4) 1 ½" strips
- Fabric C (purple in example
 - Cut (2) 1 ¼" strips
 - Cut (1) 1 ½" strip

Construction

• Sew four strips sets:

Set #1: B-A-B (1 ½", 1 ¼", 1 ½")

Set #2: B-C-B (1 ½", 1 ¼", 1 ½")

Set #3: B-A (1 ¼", 1 ¼")

Set #4: B-C (1 ¼", 1 ¼")


Press all seam allowances away from fabric B



- Cut set #1 into (9) 3 ¼" segments
- Cut set #2 into (9) 3 ¼" segments



- Sew the set #1 segments to set #3
- Sew the set #2 segments to set #4



- Trim sections
- Press away from fabric B



- Alternating color and direction, join the T segments together to form a band
- Press seam allowances to one side



- Sew a fabric A (1 ½") strip to the top
- Sew a fabric C (1 ½") strip to the bottom



This band would look great using red, white and black fabrics!
