

Ricky Tims' Harmonic Convergence
Class taught by Kathy Hilton

Class description: Have you been intrigued by Ricky Tims' "Convergence Quilt," but thought that it was too difficult to try on your own? In this class, you will learn a streamlined technique for producing the top for this mysterious and magical wall hanging. This quilt design is made from ONLY 4 fat-quarters of fabric.

Requirements: 4 Fat Quarters of Fabric (18" x 22")

Choose colors of fabric that you feel will work well together. A fabric in a dark value, one in a light value and two fabrics of medium value make a pleasing combination. If you are insecure about the fabrics, use a pre-packaged fat quarter packet collection.

The finished quilt is approximately 30" x 30" and includes borders made from the fat quarters. For alternative borders, an additional one-half yard piece will be enough for 3" borders.

In addition to the 4 fat quarters, you will need a sheet of Steam-A-Seam 2 or comparable double-stick fusible web for the appliquéd motif.

For class you will need:

Sewing machine and supplies

Rotary cutter

Cutting mat

Scissors

Acrylic rulers: 6" x 12" **and** 6" x 24" and/or 15" square ruler

Thread

Pre-wind 2 bobbins with grey or neutral color
