

LANDSCAPE WORKSHOP – MARJAN KLUEPFEL

Create your own original Landscape wall quilt. Learn about essential design principles to make a beautiful fantasy view or bring that inspiring photograph. This workshop is suitable for new and experienced quilters. We'll be creating a fabric collage using fused (or traditional) applique, free-motion machine embroidery and thread painting. Bobbin drawing and couching will provide extra texture. Learn how to sew from back to front, following your own drawing or my patterns. All levels.

Materials List

Fabric pieces (fat quarters or larger), some prints that remind you of rocks, grass, water, sky, etc. Hand-dyed fabric will be for sale during the workshop \$20/yard. Batting for the “fast workers”. 2 yds of fusible web such as Wonder Under or Steam-a-Seam. Small piece of tear away stabilizer. Sewing supplies including scissors, pins, machine embroidery threads (Teflon pressing sheet). And last but not least ... a sewing machine in good working order. It doesn't have to be a fancy machine as long as you can either lower or cover the feed dogs for free-motion embroidery and quilting I recommend using Topstitch or embroidery needles for this project. A darning foot is a must too. Patterns available: “Golden Gate Bridge”, “Amsterdam” and “Cobblestone Creek”, \$10each.
