Yardage Requirements 3/4 yard main fabric 3/8 yard second fabric 5/8 yard third fabric


1) main fabric: cut 3 strips $3 / 12$ " $x$ wof (four-patch) cut 4 strips 5" x wof (outer border)
2) second fabric cut 3 strips $3 / 12^{\prime \prime} x$ wof (four-patch)
3) third fabric cut 3 srips $61 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ xy wof sub-cut into $1561 / 2$ squares

Sewing Instructions

1) Sew three $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from each main fabric and second fabric Diagram 1. Press and subcut into $3031 / 2$ " sections
2) Sew to make 15 four-patch squares, should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
3) Sew the four-patch squares and the $61 / 2$ " squares, alternating to form the patterns in Diagram 2.
4) Measure outer borders to size of quilt. Sew side borders first and top borders second.
5) Sew on binding to complete the quilt.
